DISASTER A DOUBLE-EDGED SWORD.

➢ Perspective.

- God is present in and sovereign over suffering. Job 36.27-37.13
 - God is wise and just. Job 28.23-28, 34.10-15, 38-41
 - Don't assume you know what He's doing. Job. 42.1-6
 - Trust in Him even when you don't understand. Job 13.15
 - Know that He loves you and is working for your good. Rom. 8.28-39

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Corinthians 2.11

- He will help you bear it. 1 Cor. 10.13
- Ask, "what can I learn from this"? Job. 34.31-32

DEALING WITH DISASTER:

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Practical Take time to mourn. Share the load.

- Talk it out.
- Pray without ceasing.
- Worship in spite of suffering.
