DON'T BE A HYPOCRITE

- > "...[don't be] like the hypocrites..."
 - God cares, not only about what we do but why we do it.
 - We will get what we seek and nothing more.
 - Ultimately, glory chasing is inauthentic and shallow.
- > "but when you _____ [do it] in secret"
 - My goal is to please God and God alone.
 - When my goal is to please God, He will reward me.
 - This is a "substence over show" type of righteousness.
